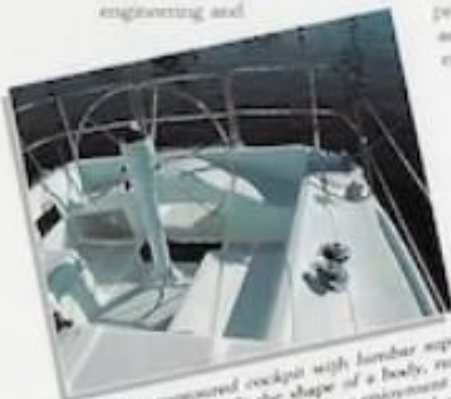

accuracy of production to assure a superior product.

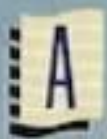

An innovative bulb-wing keel balances good performance with smooth motion and reduced draft. Her excellent sailing qualities and construction are complemented by comfort, convenience and unprecedented value.



Our deep contoured cockpit with lumbar support is designed to fit the shape of a body, not the shape of a box. Much of your enjoyment is spent in the sunshine and seawater, and we encourage you to compare the intelligence of design in this often ignored area.



The halyards and reef lines are led off to line stoppers and self-tailing winches so the sails can be easily raised, lowered and trimmed from the comfort and convenience of the cockpit.

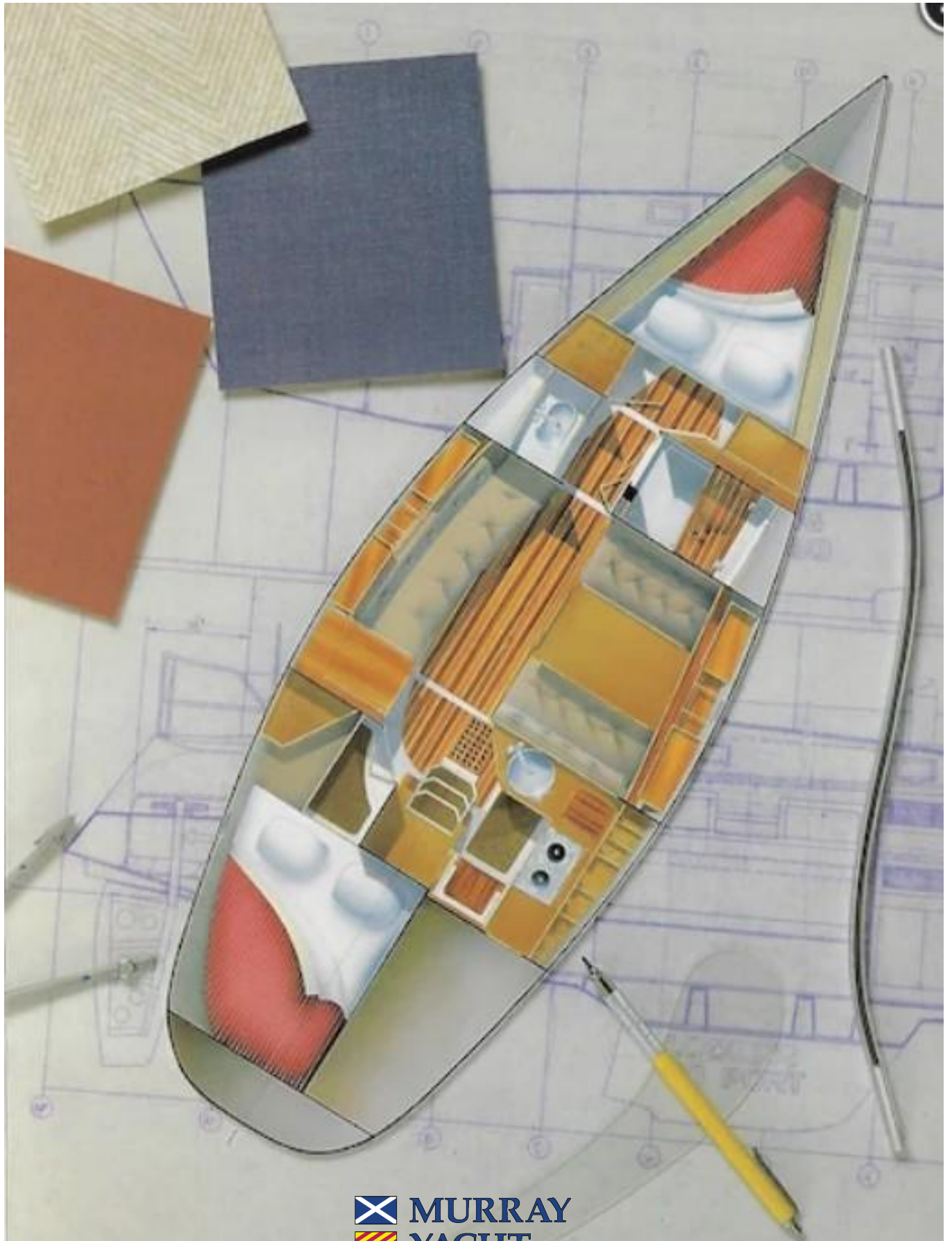

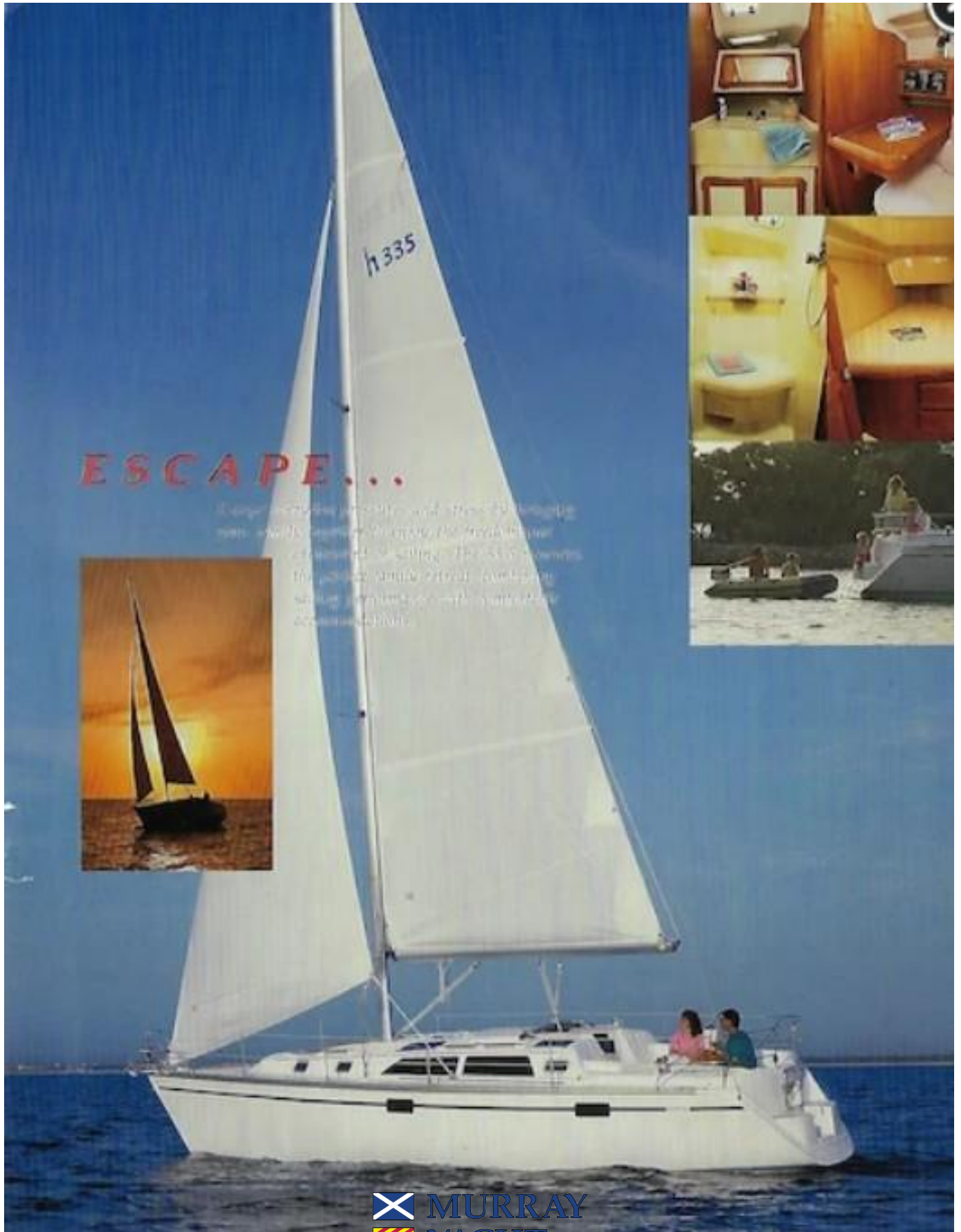

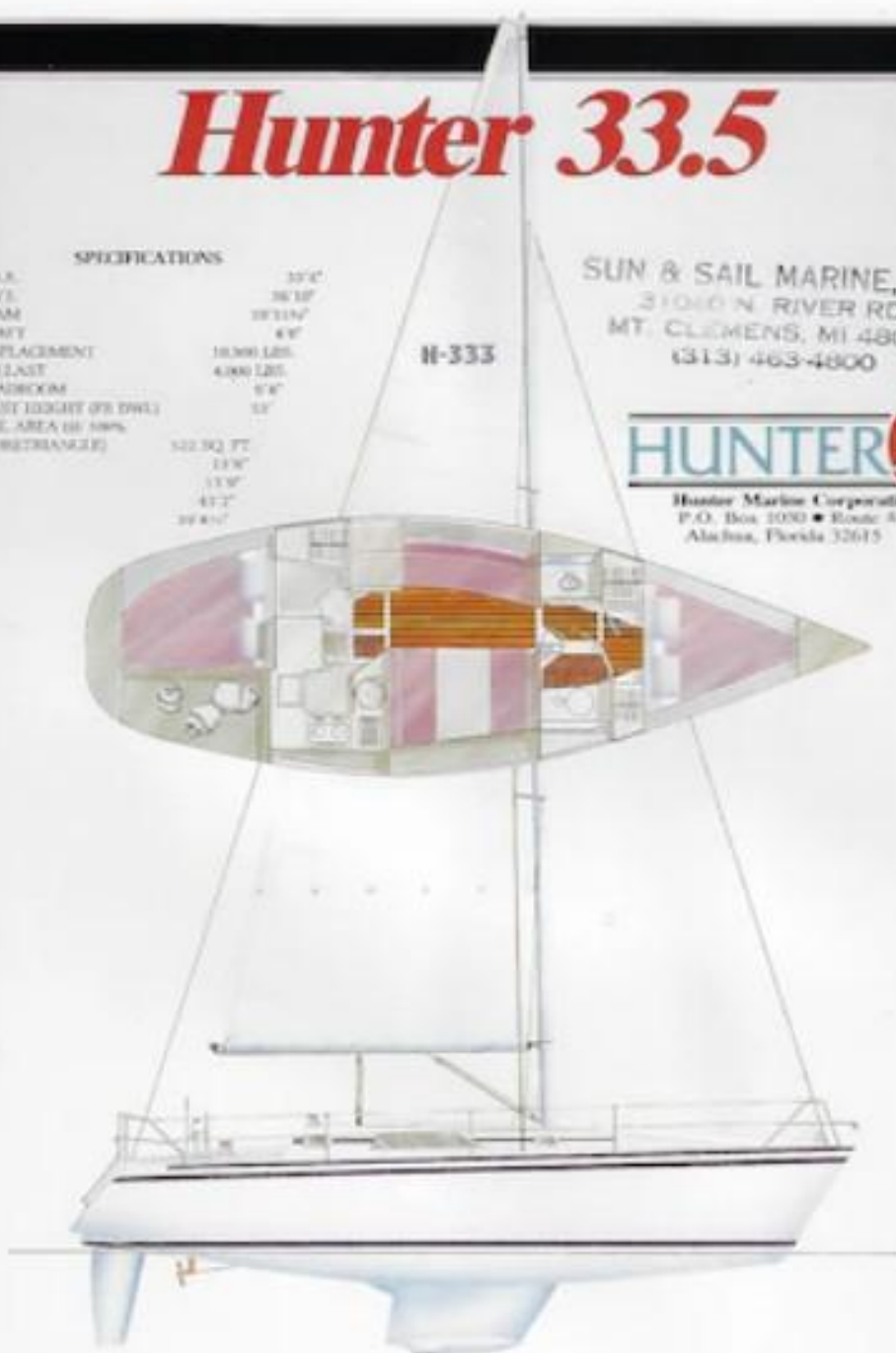
