CONSTRUCTION

Hull of hand-laid solid GRP bonded to a structural grid/hull liner of directional fiberglass/GRP for a strong, stiff, light composite. Vinyl ester hull barrier coat to resist osmotic blistering and zone-specific stitchmat laminates for specific increased strength optimization.

Cored GRP sandwich construction for stiffness, thermal and acoustic insulation and lighter weight. Solid fiberglass reinforcements in high load areas. Integral unidirectional GRP deck beams for added strength. Main bulkheads bonded 360° to the hull and deck for rigid torsional and compressive strength.

Anodized aluminum mast and boom

(2) Opening ports on the coachroof, 27 7/16" x 7 9/16" w/ curtain.
(2) Halogen overhead lights and (4) halogen reading lights
Storage cupboards behind settees
Large panoramic overhead fixed ports with blinds

COMPANIONWAY

The companionway steps hinge for access to the engine
Wood steps with anti-slip treads
