Powerful Performance

The sun's rays gently warms your skin as the cool southwest wind picks up and fills her sails. Gliding effortlessly across the water, her powerful hull moves you with emotion as well as toward your destination.

Equipped with some of the finest luxuries desired by any sailor, the Tartan 4600 offers an array of kingly commodities both on deck and down below. Whether its aboard the dual cockpit design, the bridge-deck or aft cockpit version, she is spacious, comfortable and easily manageable.

Suited for serious cruising by a crew or couple, her masthead rig (standard 59'6" or tall rig 65'5") and lines are all arranged for easy handling. Main halyard, reefs and main sheet are all led aft, and are conveniently tucked under a cabin top tunnel to avoid deck clutter. In addition, the electric main halyard winch, oversized sail handling winches, cockpit adjustable genoa lead and Harken Batslide mainsail system are just a few of the thoughtful touches available.





With either 1015 or 1170 square feet of total sail, she moves exceptionally well. Assisted by an optional roller furling 135% headsail and fully batten mainsail, she points well, tacks smoothly and accelerates nicely. However, should one roll the genny and drop the main into the lazy jack system, she hits from 7 to 9 knots under the power of a 62Hp diesel.

The shape of her hull depicts a vessel with authority and agility, easily propelled through the water regardless of the conditions. The balanced spade rudder and beavertail keel or keel/centerboard option provide the appropriate directional and lateral stability for control under all circumstances, while her steering ability is as responsive as a boat five feet shorter and several thousand pounds lighter.

The use of innovative materials and methods for construction fabricate strong, light and well-insulated hull and deck structures (Displacement 28,000 lbs.) Laminated from the highest grade NPG/Isothalic gel coat, vinylester and polyester resins and unidirectional "E" glass on a balsa core, she yields a high strength to weight ratio. Extensive framing, structural floor timbers and full structurally bonded bulkheads further maintain her hull rigidity, while allowing for greater load carrying ability.



Entering the main salon, the spacious interior creates a pleasing gathering place for entertaining, dining or relaxing. Built to best suit the styles of her owner,




